The average daytime temperature in Kandersteg at the time we are going is 18.c.

Kandersteg is situated 1,200 mts above sea level. Warley is around 300 mts above sea level. The summit of Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain stands at 1,344 mts above sea level.

When we step off the train at the top of the Jungfrau we will be at a height of 3,454 mts

Kandersteg International Scout Centre is run by a team of volunteers called Pinkies. They can be recognised by their pink t-shirts.

Around 1,200 people live in Kandersteg – so when the Campsite is full the population more than doubles! Tourism and farming are the main industries with around 20 hotels, lots of farms and a Buddhist monastery.

Kandersteg International Scout Centre is the only world centre of the World Organisation of the Scout Movement (WOSM). The Centre began in 1923 with Baden-Powell, who, after the first World Scout Jamboree had a dream about a place where all Scouts from all over the world could meet.

His dream came true and now YOU have the opportunity to visit Kandersteg International Scout Centre and live YOUR Dream!
